Kelly King Horne is Homeward's Executive Director. Her professional background is in organizational development, board governance, nonprofit management and affordable housing. From 2005 to 2006, she served as Program and Development Director and, prior to that, she worked as the Manager for Community Initiatives on Homelessness with the United Way of Greater Richmond & Petersburg from 2003 until 2005.

From 1995 to 2003, Kelly worked in Europe and the former Soviet Union with Habitat for Humanity International and with the Peace Corps. Kelly served as a Programme Development Manager with Habitat for Humanity and worked particularly with Habitat affiliates in Romania, Armenia, and Northern Ireland. She also created the international staff training curriculum for Habitat for Humanity Europe/Central Asia.

Kelly serves as Homeward's representative on the Virginia Coalition to End Homelessness board and serves on the Affordability Workgroup of the Virginia Housing Commission and the City of Richmond Community Criminal Justice Board. Kelly received her M.A. in Religious Studies from Stanford University in 1993 and her B.A. in Interdisciplinary Studies from the American University in Washington, D.C. In 2007, Kelly was named one of the Richmond region's "Top 40 Under 40" by *Style Weekly*.
